Also in March, it's training time. We're going to be doing Solo Tech, Registration, and Timing & Scoring on Saturday March 20th, and Solo Safety Steward on March 21st. If you're interested in the Safety Steward training, you should have a rulebook (or access to the online one) and have a couple years of experience running in the Solo program and must let me know you're coming. Schedules are still TBD but I promise we won't start until after 9:00am! The training will be at the Jet-Express station at 85th & Blondo in Omaha.

It's pretty easy, but we do need people to run the various areas of the event. I'd love to get some new blood involved in this program. Don't be shy, we'll be more than happy to train you.

Hopefully this will be a little more relaxed schedule. The next weekend, April 17th-18th is our first Club Race event at Mid-America Motorplex. Whether driver, volunteer, or spectator, we'd like to see you there. Also, maybe a Road Rally sometime this year? How's that for a teaser!

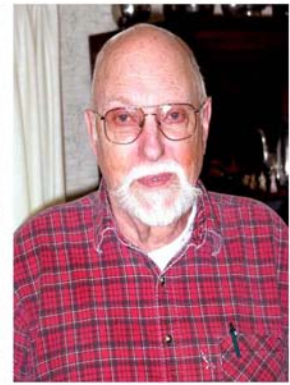
NRSCCA's had 9 Founders in March 1954

Jerome Ritter, Ass't RE in 1955.



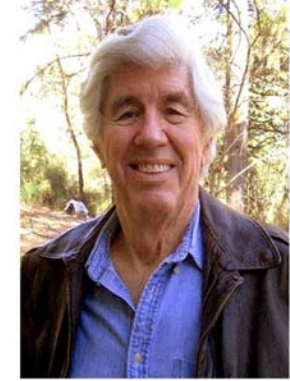

Tire Walls

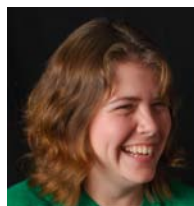
